 <p><u>Egypt & Mesopotamia Gallery</u> Sumerian cuneiform tablet listing an inventory of cattle.</p>	 <p><u>Americas Gallery</u> New Mexican Acoma Pueblo ceramic depicting a deer.</p>	 <p><u>European Gallery</u> Ukrainian Easter egg decorated from duck, goose, or chicken eggs, traditionally called a Pysanka.</p>	 <p><u>Mediterranean Gallery</u> Plaster cast of a Roman sculpture of a boy playfully wrestling a goose.</p>	 <p><u>African Gallery</u> West African Yoruba crown worn by local Oba, topped by the mythical bird Odùduwà.</p>
 <p><u>African Gallery</u> Yoruban wooden carving of a crocodile from Nigeria.</p>	 <p><u>European Gallery</u> Jewish ram horn trumpet called a Shofar, used to mark holy days like Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur.</p>	 <p><u>European Gallery</u> Late Medieval Italian sarcophagus depiction of a dog loyally guarding their deceased human.</p>	 <p><u>Asia & Oceania Gallery</u> Japanese okimono depicting a crab.</p>	 <p><u>African Gallery</u> Zimbabwean decorated ostrich egg canteen.</p>
